Zetech University unveils students' 'Roll of Honor Programme'

According to Ms Muhia, all



these elements will be captured in a student log book; which is a record of all the activities that the student will engage in.

Speaking at the launch of the programme, Vice Chancellor Prof. Edwin Wamukoya challenged the students to aim to be solution providers and become the pick of the bunch of their generation after the three months of intensive training.

“You should show active participation in this programme and I would want to see you visit no less than five different universities whenever there is a public lecture so that you can learn and network; this will broaden your experience, increase your knowledge and build your networks,” said Wamukoya.

The launch of the programme is part of continued efforts by the varsity to produce all round graduates who are well equipped to join and excel in the job market.
