"We are living in an era where information is disseminated spontaneously and in real-time. To stand out, we are called upon to prioritize extensive reporting, investigative journalism, and verification of information so that we engage with our audience in a meaningful and credible manner", he said.

The launch of the new programs was also well-received by students, who expressed interest in progressing from their diploma to bachelor levels of study in the ongoing intake. "I am excited about the Bachelor of Science in Media and Digital Communication program," said Michelle, a diploma finalist student at Zetech University. 




