Boost to Transport Sector as Zetech University unveils Solar-powered TukTuk

The transport sector has received a major boost after Zetech University came up with an electric powered tuk-tuk, presenting a significant step towards radically improving the sector and reducing carbon emissions.

Zetech University Lecturer Prof. Gitau Kamau said the engineless tuktuk runs on electric motors and has rechargeable batteries that could last for more than 100 km and that it also has solar panels integrated across its roof to harness solar energy which charges the batteries.



e said it is built like other tuktuks though it is faster with a speed of over 60 km/hr but it's priced slightly higher than the normal tuktuks at Sh450, 000.

"We have assembled the tuktuk, put in electric motors and solar panels to recharge its batteries once they get drained. It is noiseless, cost effective and clean, "said Prof Kamau during Zetech University's Research and Innovation week.

Recently, former Investment, Trade and Industrialization Cabinet Secretary Rebecca Maino said the country expects to have moved fully towards the use of electric buses by 2027 in line with the government's agenda of transforming the transport sector through the reduction of carbon emissions to address the negative effects of climate change.

Men's mental health: 'Man up' is not the answer

On July 11th, 2024, Zetech University advanced its mission to shape the future by hosting a pivotal mental health event focusing on the boy child. The event was to "Embrace the Men's Moment, " this title aimed to raise awareness about men's mental health and the importance of emotional expression.

The orator of the day, Mr. Atanda Oluwa Femi, addressed an unexpected audience of both males and females. He began by explaining the theme of the event, "Breaking the Silence.

"He emphasised that "men can cry," challenging long-held societal norms that discourage men from showing vulnerability. Surveys from around the world find that males everywhere are reluctant to talk about their mental health and are more likely to die by suicide than females.

Atanda shared his personal life story, highlighting the significance of self-expression for men. He pointed out that while the Girl Child

Empowerment movement has been in the spotlight since the 19th century; societal norms, cultural expectations, and stigma have continued to silence men.

"It was at the point when I spoke out about my situation that I got help concerning my homelessness, "Atanda revealed, illustrating the transformative power of speaking up.






